2) ROAD

A24 highway (autostrada) easily connects Rome and L'Aquila. If you drive your car, you have to leave autostrada at L'AQUILA OVEST exit; then turn right after the toll-gate and at the stop turn right again. Follow the sign to SCUOLA SUPERIORE G. REISS ROMOLI. Drive for about 2km and you will meet the building located on your left a hillside.

CLIMATE AND DRESS

April in L'Aquila is often beautiful, dry and sunny, with daytime high temperature typically of 15-20° C and nighttime 0-5° C. However the temperature could easily reach 25° C or more, or fall at freezing, and rain can occur. Bringing a warm jacket for outdoor activities is suggested.
